From Hartford

- I-91 South to Exit 17 - Route 15 South/Wilbur Cross Parkway
- Wilbur Cross Parkway turns into the Merritt Parkway after the Stratford Bridge
- Take the first exit after crossing the bridge, Exit 53
- Take a right off the exit ramp and your first left onto Oronoque Lane
- Proceed through one stop sign, the club is straight ahead on the left at 385 Oronoque Lane.

From New Haven

- I-95 South to Exit 38 - Merritt Parkway
- Stay in left lane to Merritt Parkway - South
- Take the first exit after crossing the bridge, Exit 53
- Take a right off the exit ramp and your first left onto Oronoque Lane
- Proceed through one Stop Sign, the club is straight ahead on the left at 385 Oronoque Lane

I-95 North (Fairfield County)

- I-95 North to Exit 27 A - Trumbull/Waterbury
- Follow signs for Shelton/Waterbury (Route 8 and Route 15)
- Take Exit 9 - Merritt Parkway (Route 15 North) to Exit 53 (Shelton/Stratford).
- Turn left off exit, pass under the Parkway, take the first left onto Oronoque Lane
- Proceed through one stop sign, the club is straight ahead on the left at 385 Oronoque Lane

Route 15 South Wilbur Cross/Merritt Parkway

- Route 15 South
- Take the first exit after crossing the bridge, Exit 53
- Take a right off the exit ramp and your first left onto Oronoque Lane
- Proceed through one Stop Sign, the club is straight ahead on the left at 385 Oronoque Lane

Route 15 North - Merritt Parkway

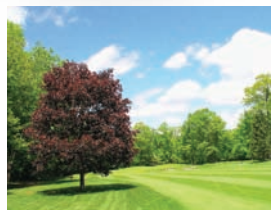
